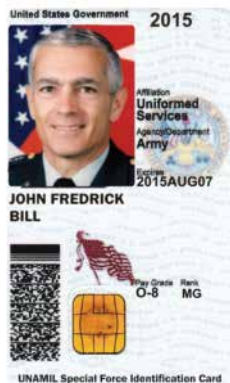


### COTS Certificate-based Offline MFA Solution

#### Enables Offline Computer Authentication

Power LogOn COA is a COTS solution. COA provides secure login authentication for offline (standalone) computer workstations using existing Smart ID credentials with digital certificates..

Power LogOn COA works out-of-the-box with most certificates as found on PIV/PIV-I/CAC/CIV credentials to facilitate secure authentication, authorization, verification, and non-repudiation for

#### Ready for Immediate Use

- ✓ User presents their credential to an online enrollment station running Power LogOn COA.
- ✓ The certificate is verified against a revocation list, and adds approved users to an enrollment file.
- ✓ The enrollment file is transferred to offline workstations.
- ✓ The user inserts their credential at offline workstation and types their PIN.
- ✓ Card's private key verifies user's information.
- ✓ Auto-fills Windows Username and Password logon. Rejects non-approved users.

#### Environment

Ideally suited for computer workstations isolated from an organization's network that require certificate-based multifactor authentication.

- ✓ Works with any credential with a valid X509 certificate.
- ✓ Does not require any additional hardware infrastructure.
- ✓ COTS, FIPS 140-2 verified, FIPS 201, HIPAA, CJIS, NIST 800-171 & 800-63b-AAL3 compliant, and self evaluated STIGs review accepted by USAF

#### Typical Customer

PIV/PIV-I/CAC/CIV and x.509 credentials are typically used by government entities and private organizations that handle security-sensitive information. Often, these organizations have highly secure workstations that must be isolated from the internet.

Power LogOn COA solves that problem, enabling these organizations to take advantage of the high level of security offered by their card, even in a non-networked setting.

Users don't need multiple credentials. Power LogOn COA is versatile because the same certificate credential can also be used on workstations and computers that are connected to a network.

Login data for additional login locations, such as local websites or applications, can also easily be entered into Power LogOn COA, enabling card-secured login for those sites.

Administrators can also opt to enroll multiple users at a central workstation. Power LogOn COA creates an enrollment file for each credential, which the administrator then transfers to the target workstations.
